EXPLANATION OF PROOF OF SERVICE

Completion of this part of the form is required only on the original petition form, which you will file with the District Court Administrator's Office of the County where the property is located. Types of proof of service are provided below. Use only one of these methods of service:

- 1) **Admission of Service:** As you deliver the required copies to the county officials, have the official (or deputy of that office) sign for the copy(ies) as you deliver them.
- 2) **Affidavit of Personal Service:** If you have someone else (who is not a party to the appeal, such as a process server) deliver the required copies of the petition to the appropriate county officials, that person must sign a notarized statement that they made the delivery.
